We are not proposing anything at the moment. The purpose of this consultation is to establish what issues are important to you in order to inform us what topics should be identified for future consultation. If it is decided to proceed with a Conservation Management Plan, a partnership approach between the stakeholders and the local community will need to be established and complex land ownership & responsibilities, limited funding and wide-ranging recreational use will have to be considered.
